

2025 Outstanding Student Achievement Awards

The Oregon Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics recognizes up to two (2) Oregon Academy student members annually.

Award purpose:

To recognize emerging leadership potential in the field of dietetics through academic success and achievements in campus and dietetic-related professional organization activities, work (paid and/or volunteer) experience, and planned professional goals.

Criteria:

- Must be an Oregon Academy student member, as of December 31st of the year prior to the award being given (i.e., for the 2025 awards, students must be Oregon Academy members as of 12/31/24)
- Can be an incoming and graduating senior, graduate student or intern

Award categories:

- (1) Outstanding Undergraduate Student
- (1) Outstanding Intern and/or Postgraduate program participant

Applications and timeline:

- Nominee submissions due February 7, 2025. (Materials sent to oand@quidnunc.net).
 - Application will include:
 - √ <u>An online application</u> (including volunteer and work experience)
 - ✓ An unofficial transcript (uploaded to the online application)
 - ✓ A resume (uploaded to the online application)
 - ✓ A candidate essay summarizing current and future professional goals, including planned professional leadership (no more than 500 words). This is completed as part of the online application.
- Applicant review February 8-20, 2025
- Award recipients named by February 28, 2025

- Academy recognition (via The Journal of the Academy Nutrition and Dietetics)
- Scholarship/grant from the Oregon Academy (\$500 per recipient)
- Special recognition on the Oregon Academy website
- Planned social media promotion and short video interviews
